Creator God, you formed the waters and the dry land, and your fingers set the stars and moon in the heavens: hear our prayers for the earth and its creatures. We pray for your people in the US during this time of civil unrest, may your love and peace enter into their hearts and unite your people into communities of justice and peace, so that they may live together in peace.

Father, in your mercy, hear our prayer.

Wisdom and Word of God, you chose to dwell with the children of humanity: hear our prayers for your worldwide church. We pray for the church in places where it is persecuted or ignored; for

church leaders especially our Bishop, our Rector and Associate Priest, and for all who minister or serve you in this community of faith of Ballina and Lennox Head during this time of isolation due to Covid-19. We also pray for our brothers and sisters in Coffs Harbour, that they, and we, may grow in understanding of your Word, with the aid of the Internet, and proclaim your gospel.

Father, in your mercy, **hear our prayer.**

Spirit of God, you hovered over the waters of creation, and you are with us today, bringing love and peace: hear the prayers for those whose lives are disadvantaged or neglected; for our families and our friends, for each other, and for ourselves. Unite your people in a community of love, that we may support the weak, care for the vulnerable, and welcome the outsiders in your midst.

Father, in your mercy, **hear our prayer.**

Three-in-one God, you give life to your people, comforting us in our sorrows and sustaining us in our needs: hear our prayers for all who suffer. We pray for the grief-stricken, the broken-hearted, and all in despair due to being isolated from their loved ones; for those who are over-worked, and for those with no work; for the sick, and for all who are close to death. Unite your people in a community of compassion, that we may bring consolation to the suffering and uphold one another in times of need. Remembering those whose names appear in our parish bulletin.
